Slip Into Style: Cardigans with ¾-length sleeves, open mesh sleeves with various lace stitches in body. Loose-fit granny square cardigan; tank top, oversized tees and tunics.

Dress It Up: Summer Flowers: flip-flop makeovers, summer hats, easy scarves and cowls, mandala earrings and necklaces, bobby pin or hair clip accents and shawls, crochet trims and applique on premade t-shirts

At Home: Take-and-go projects: Afghans made using granny squares or strips, table runners, pillows, dishcloths in bright summer colors; add pompom and tassels when possible. Recycled everyday home items by using crochet.

Baby Love: Oversized stuffed animals, baby sandals or shoes, and blankets


